
Birth Control Method Effectiveness of Birth Control Methods

 - If/when you might want to get pregnant in the future
- Whether the method offers additional health benefits in addition to birth control
- Whether it needs cooperation from your partnerYou age, overall health, and any medical conditions
- How often you have sex
- How often you will need to see your health care professional for refills or visits
- Possible side effects of the method
- Whether it needs cooperation from your partnerWhether it helps protect against human
- whether it helps protect against numan immunodeficiency virus (HIV) and other sexually transmitted infections (STIs)
